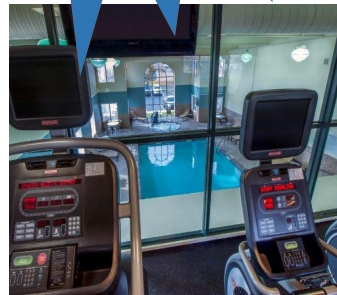

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rulebook will be judged in accordance therewith.

While every attempt has been made to avoid mistakes in this prize list, publication, website and/or email, Buffalo International Horse Show, its management and employees assume no liability for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted in accordance with USEF Rules.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right in itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes management deems is in the best interest of the show and its exhibitors.

### 2024 USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) headline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:** I have read the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") Entry Agreement (GR906.4) as printed in the Prize List for The Buffalo International Horse Show ("Competition") and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Federation Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos from the competition, and agree that any actions against the Federation must be brought in New York State. The complete statement is as follows: **FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT** By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

**STATEMENT AS TO FEDERATION FEE (GR407.1-3)** For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$23 Federation Fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs & Medication Fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs).  
**USHJA Zone Fee:** \$7 per entry.

### USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such

devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**USEF/USHJA CREDENTIALS AND MEASUREMENT CARDS:** To be eligible to compete at Federation Licensed Competitions, coaches, trainers, and legal guardians signing as coaches or trainers on behalf of their minors must be Senior Active Members in good standing, as defined herein. All participants must present to the show secretary current USEF and USHJA membership cards or copies thereof. Amateur certification, and measurement cards for Junior Hunters and Pony Hunters must be presented to the horse show secretary before numbers will be issued. Horses and ponies without a current valid measurement card issued by USEF will be measured by the horse show steward. Measurements will be conducted on Thursday at 3:00pm or by special arrangement.

**NEW – USEF SHOW PASS FEE:** Effective 12-1-2022 any rider, handler, driver, or owner are limited to one USEF Show Pass purchase annually (December 1-November 30). USEF Show Pass will be available for purchase by exhibitors online only. USEF Membership will be required in order to compete for anyone who has not purchased a Show Pass through their USEF portal. Trainers and Coaches are no longer eligible to participate under a Show Pass and must be an Active USEF member.

**HORSE IDENTIFICATION AND RECORDING (GR1101):** All horses competing in Federation licensed competitions must be properly identified. For all such competitions, entries for each horse must include either a Federation-issued Unique Horse Identification Number or a registration number from a Federation Recognized Affiliate. Additionally, a Federation Recognized Discipline Affiliate may require horses to be registered with their organization, and if so, the entry must also include that registration number. 2. The Federation will issue only one Unique Horse ID Number per horse. This Unique Horse ID number must subsequently remain with the horse in perpetuity, and shall not be changed for any reason, including upgrade from Unique Horse ID to a Recording, change of ownership, change of name, or death. 3. Prior to submitting an application for a new Unique Horse ID number, it is the owner's responsibility to verify the current ID status of a horse through a Horse Recording/ID search, (the assistance of Federation staff may be requested). Anyone who knowingly seeks to obtain an additional Unique Horse ID Number for a horse which has previously been issued one is subject to disciplinary action. 4. The Federation must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. 5. Owners are requested to notify the Federation of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings. 6. A Unique Horse ID number can be upgraded to Federation recording. The Unique Horse ID Number will remain the same. 7. Applications for Unique Horse ID Numbers and/or recordings can be completed online at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org) using the Horse application form which can also be downloaded. The ID application form is also available on request from the Federation office, and from competition management. 8. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors in their prize lists of the Unique Horse ID Number requirement, and availability of Horse ID Number application forms. 9. There will be no charge for Unique Horse ID Numbers that are issued via the internet to members of USEF or its affiliates for: 1) horses that are life recorded, registered or otherwise identified or listed with a USEF discipline affiliate, or 2) horses registered with a USEF breed affiliate. Horses not meeting the above criteria must have a completed USEF Horse application indicating on the application the request for a Horse ID before a number will be issued. This form can be completed on the internet, free of charge, at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org)

**USHJA Horse Registrations.** All horses competing in federation non-breed restricted competitions must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA (exception: opportunity, academy, exhibition, walk-trot and lead line). A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms. Visit [www.ushja.org](http://www.ushja.org).

**MICROCHIPPING.** All horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete in Federation licensed competitions. Exceptions: USHJA Outreach and those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9.

**ENTRIES:** Competitors are encouraged to submit their show entries online at [www.horseshowing.com](http://www.horseshowing.com).

**Entries will close September 1, 2024.** Entries will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner or his exhibitor's agent, trainer and rider and accompanied by a check. **CREDIT CARDS NOT ACCEPTED.** Be sure to include the USEF/USHJA Membership Numbers of your trainer, rider and owner's USEF/USHJA Membership Numbers on the entry form. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order and form of payment received. All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their Amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. All persons listed on entry blank are required to sign the USEF Liability and Waiver.

**Non-member USHJA fee \$30 to USHJA.**

**SCHOOLING, WARMUP, LUNGEING:**

**NEW USEF RULE HJ106.c.d.e.:** All horses in the schooling area or warm-up area must have its show number attached to the horse or the individual riding or handling. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area. All horses in the exercise area must have its show number attached to the horse or the individual exercising. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area. All horses being lunged in the designated lunging area, or anywhere else on show grounds, must have its show number attached to the horse or the individual lunging. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area.

**HEAD GEAR:** It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear in compliance with the accepted testing standards published on the Federation's website. Protective headgear must carry the applicable quality testing tag and/or label. It must be properly fitted with harness secured.

### RULES GOVERNING THE AWARDS

To be eligible for High Score Awards, all horses and ponies must be nominated and the person(s) in whose name(s) the horse or pony is showing, or the child who is showing in horsemanship classes, must be a current member of the Syracuse Chapter PHA. No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dues and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary. **THE**

**SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES** Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and one change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6" &/or 3'3"; fences for Children's Hunters Horses and Adult Riders 3'; fences for Children's Hunters Large Ponies 2'6", Small-Medium Ponies 2', Low-Child & Low-Adult Horses 2'6", Low-Child Ponies 2'. Medal Class USEF Tests for Jr Hunter Riders 1-22; All others . Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Every Member show is required to offer a Jr, Children's & Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. Other medals are optional. Management may offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies and/or Pre-Children's Ponies. Horses and riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show. Children's Pony riders may enter the USEF Pony Medal **Additional rules explained in the current Syracuse PHA Rule Book.**

GREEN HUNTERS - Use USEF Rule HU131

Syracuse PHA will follow the USEF rules for the Green Hunters 3' & 3'3" sections.

LOW ADULT & LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTERS will follow the the USHJA Zone 2 Specifications.

**ELECTRONIC DEVICES:** The unsafe use of electronic devices, as determined by the competition steward in their sole discretion, including cell phones, with or without earphones/buds while mounted is prohibited in all areas designated for schooling and exercise, and while lunging horses on competition grounds. Earphone(s) / Earbud(s) are prohibited in all areas designated for schooling & exercise.

**DOGS:** Per USEF Rule GR1301.6 dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards.

**SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org). As of Jan 1, 2019 every USEF adult member (18 years of age or older) must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training. Failure to complete the safe sport training will disqualify you from competing in any capacity until it is completed.

**HORSE/PONY HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** All animals entering the show grounds, whether competing or for schooling only, must present a current negative Coggins test dated within a year of that competition. Per **USEF GR-844 Equine Vaccination Rule:** At Federation Licensed Competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus & Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months of entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule will be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

**STALLS:** Limited stabling in permanent stalls with doors is available at \$170.00 per stall for the show, prior to closing date. After close date, stall price is \$200.00. Stalls will be assigned by the committee on a first come, first served basis. No stall will be reserved without payment. No initial bedding will be provided. Stalls have dirt floors. All horses must have stalls. Due to space constraints, showing from trailers is not allowed.

**DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS** Current USEF rules and regulations regarding D & M will be enforced. Sharps and medical waste must be disposed of in sharps containers placed around the barns. All competitors are asked to comply with the USEF Testing Veterinarians in a courteous and efficient manner. **Please note that sharps containers MUST be used as provided in stabling areas or penalties will occur. (GR1210.4)**

**JUDGING:** All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners unless otherwise specified. Jogging in Children's and Adult Amateur hunter sections will be at the judge's discretion.

**COURTESY CIRCLE:** The area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line that will be indicated on the course diagram and accompanying barrier will be erected on the course.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** The Buffalo Therapeutic Riding Center, its show management, agents and employees will in no case be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show and, it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Buffalo Therapeutic Riding Center, their show management, agents and employees harmless for any illness, loss or accident which may occur. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages caused by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

- Numbers will not be issued to competitors without a signed open check; presentation of all Measurement cards; Amateur credentials; a copy of negative Coggins test within 12 months of competition and prove of Equine Influenza Virus & Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months of entering the stables. A \$20 office/EMT fee will be charged for all horses. There are no scratch/add fees.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes as deemed necessary. Sections will be combined/split per current USEF rules.
- Management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry or, to return any entry fees before or during the show without being liable for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges or officials on the part of any owner, rider, trainer or groom shall disqualify the entry and the responsible party shall forfeit entry and other fees.
- All riders must wear **proper attire** including proper **approved headgear** at all times while mounted on the show grounds.

6. **Prize money** will be paid through the show office. All prize money in excess of balances due will be mailed within 30 days following the conclusion of the horse show. Tax ID's are required for all prize money recipients. All prize money shall be divided as follows unless otherwise specified: 1st-30% / 2nd-22% / 3rd-15% / 4th-12% / 5th-11% / 6th-10%.
7. **Dogs must be leashed** at all times while on the grounds.
8. It is a condition of entry that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
9. **JUMP ORDERS:** Rotating jump orders will be used for all classes over fences.
10. Eight ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise noted.
11. **ALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN U.S. FUNDS. CREDIT CARDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** All accounts must be settled in full at the show. There will be a \$50 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. Returned checks must be replaced by certified funds, cash or money order.

You must include signatures for owners, riders and trainers, membership numbers and copies of USEF/USHJA membership cards. A USEF Liability Waiver must be signed by all persons listed on entry form.
13. **SCHOOLING:** Daily schooling schedules will be posted. No lungeing in the ring during schooling hours. **Show issued back numbers must be worn when schooling, exercising, lungeing.**
14. All **NON-SHOWING HORSES** will be charged a fee of \$100.00.
15. **ARRIVALS** can be accommodated **ONLY** between the hours of 8am and 6pm unless prior arrangements have been made with the stabling manager. Unless otherwise specified and arranged for in advance, horses must vacate their stalls no later than 9:00am Monday. Exhibitors must obtain a release from the show office prior to removing horses from the show grounds.
16. **REFUNDS:** No stall refunds will be made under any circumstances after the close of entries. Before the close of entries all fees will be refunded upon receipt of cancellation notice. Prior to arrival on the show grounds, entry fees shall be refunded upon presentation of a statement signed by a veterinarian (or a medical doctor in case of a rider) stating that the horse or rider is unable to perform in the class(es) entered. 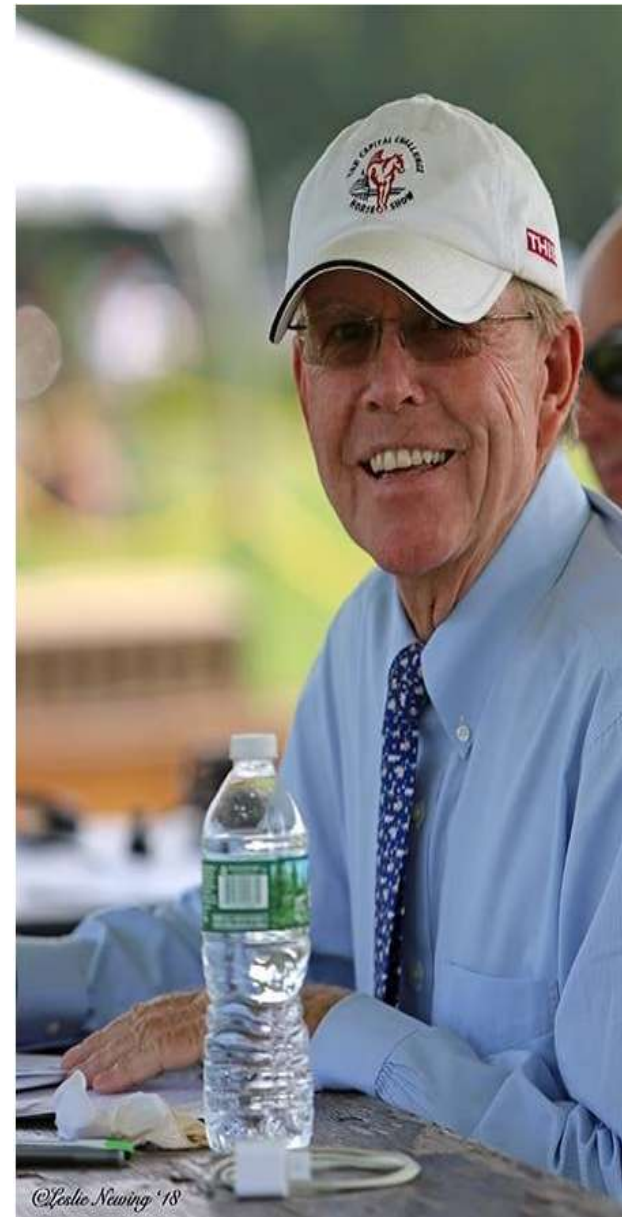

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

Horse ownership transfers and lease registrations must be completed with **BOTH USEF and USHJA BEFORE THE START OF THE COMPETITION** in order for points to count toward Qualifying for USEF and USHJA Programs or Championships (i.e. qualifying classes at Devon Horse Show, USHJA Gladstone Cup Equitation Classic for Juniors at USEF Junior Hunter National Championships, Zone Finals, etc.) as well as Hunter and/or Jumper National and Zone Horse of the Year awards.

Horses entered only in these classes: a. are exempt from the Federation fee, including the Equine Drugs and Medication fee. b. are not required to have a Horse Identification (HID) or Recording Number but are to list the HID or Recording number if the horse has been assigned this number. 5. Riders/drivers/handlers entered only in these classes are exempt from the Federation membership requirements and are not required to pay a Show Pass fee but are required to list the Federation membership number if the participant is a member. 6. The prize list must state whether or not horses and/or riders/drivers/handlers entered in Opportunity Classes can cross enter into the rated/recognized classes at the same competition. *If cross entry is allowed, all applicable fees and membership requirements apply.*
